CFD Website Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy was last updated on October 31, 2022.

This Cookie Policy explains what Cookies are, and how we use them. You should read this policy so you can understand what type of Cookies we use, the information we collect using Cookies and how that information is used. For the purposes of this Cookies Policy, "the website" refers to https://centreforfacdev.ca/.

Your information may be collected through the use of Cookies, which are small data files placed on your device (e.g. computer) that allow us to collect certain information whenever you visit or interact with the website or online services.

The Cookies we use do not allow us to identify individuals. These cookies are not used for any purposes other than those described here such as to determine the number of visitors to the website, visitor locations, the pages they visited and other activities to ensure the optimization of the website. They are used to save preferences, to compile statistical information and to assess and improve the efficiency of the Website. A mix of first-party and third-party Cookies are used:

- First-party Cookies are set by the website you are visiting.
- Third-party Cookies are set by other owners of websites you are visiting (e.g., YouTube). The websites you visit may contain content embedded and these organizations may set their own Cookies.

Cookies are used for the purposes set out below:

- Essential Cookies: is used to provide you with services through the Website and enable some features. They are used for authenticating users.
- Functionality Cookies: Also known as preferences cookies, is used to remember your choices, preferences and keep you signed in.
- Persistent Cookies: can be re-read when you return to the website and are used to identify and provide
 personalized features and for tracking traffic patterns to and from the Website.
- Tracking & Performance Cookies: is used to track information about site traffic, determine popularity of
 content, and trends to optimize the site users' experience, and generally understanding online behaviours
 and interests of those who interact with the site and services.

You may disable Cookies through your individual browser options/settings. However, in a few cases, some of the website features may not function as a result.
